

Need help pricing your gear?

This is very generic advice for recreational skiers based on past sales. If you know your equipment well, and know how others looking for that equipment might value it, use your judgment. This guidance does not replace specialized knowledge.

- Make sure it's clean and in good working order.
- Gather make & model info for ski/snowboard equipment, ideally with info about who and what it's designed for: men/women? beginners/experts/racers? Alpine/Nordic/Backcountry/Telemark? Put this info on the tag.
- Price it well! Price to sell! Nobody wants to take home unsold gear on Sunday.

Pricing suggestions for used gear:

SKIS

- Adult Alpine: \$100-200
- Youth Alpine: \$60-120
- Kids Alpine: \$25-75
- Backcountry: \$120-220
- Telemark: \$100-200
- Race stock: depends on condition
- Adult skate: \$100-180
- Adult regular x-c \$70-150
- Youth skate: \$30-50
- Youth regular x-c \$30-50
- Kids x-c \$10-50

SNOWBOARDS \$60-100

BOOTS

- Alpine boots \$50-100
- Youth Alpine boots: \$20-40
- Kids' Alpine boots: \$10-30
- Race stock boots: depends on condition
- Adult x-c boots \$20-40
- Youth x-c boots \$15-25
- Kids' x-c boots \$5-20
- Snowboard boots: \$25-50
- Telemark boots: \$25-50

POLES

- Alpine poles \$10-15
- Nordic poles \$20-30
