# Cochran's Junior Ski Coach Job Description

## **Responsibilities May Include:**

Training at Cochran's (in coordination with Lead Coach)

- 1. Assist Lead Coach and Assistant Coach in set up and take down of the day's activity / course.
- 2. Engage kids in the day's training activity / course, encouraging them to have fun while focusing on improvement
- 3. Help maintain a safe training environment by potentially setting up / taking down b-net, managing course traffic, etc.
- 4. Encourage athletes to cheer on their peers and support one another through positive feedback
- 5. Help athletes up the t-bar or teach athletes how to ride the rope

Race Day Responsibilities (in coordination with Lead Coach)

- 1. Assist Lead Coach and Assistant Coach to perform course inspection with racers in groups.
- 2. Help athletes safely ride the lift to the race course.
- 3. Assist racers with preparation for their race run at the top of the course.
- 4. Give individualized encouragement to racers over the course of the day.
- 5. Encourage the Club kids to act as a team and cheer on team mates during their runs.

### **Expectations Include:**

- Maintaining flexibility
- Willingness to learn
- Ability to take direction, work as a team, and work independently
- Positive engagement with athletes and parents
- USSA Coach or Junior Coach license and SafeSport training (paid by Cochran's Ski Club)
- Attend orientation session in December

Any High School age athlete with previous ski racing experience, a desire to learn how to coach, and the willingness to commit to the program for the full season. Preference will be given to applicants who demonstrate maturity, reliability, and enthusiasm for the job.
