All members should register online and complete payment in full with registration. All skiers in the Club, whether racing or just training, must have a U.S. Ski & Snowboard membership. Club members who will not compete in U.S. Ski & Snowboard races require only the General Membership from U.S. Ski & Snowboard. All others require a U.S. Ski & Snowboard Competitor license and Vermont Alpine Race Association (VARA) license.

U8 (6 or 7 years old as of December 31, 2022) \$180.00

U10 (8 or 9 years old as of December 31, 2022) \$350.00

U12 (10 or 11 years old as of December 31, 2022) \$580.00

U14 (12 or 13 years old as of December 31, 2022) \$880.00

U16/U18/U21 (14 years and older as of December 31, 2022) \$1265.00

U.S. Ski & Snowboard membership is required, at least at the general level for all athletes.

- Alpine General Non-Competitor (17 & under) - \$35
- Alpine Competitor U12 and under (11 & under) - \$100
- Alpine Competitor U14 (12-13) - \$125
- Alpine Competitor U16 and over (14 & over) - \$200
- Alpine Non-Scored Athlete (14-24) - \$100 (Does not include access to U.S. Ski & Snowboard points list)
