All members should register online and complete payment in full with registration. All skiers in the Club, whether racing or just training, must have a U.S. Ski & Snowboard membership. Club members who will not compete in U.S. Ski & Snowboard races require only the General Membership from U.S. Ski & Snowboard. All others require a U.S. Ski & Snowboard Competitor license and Vermont Alpine Race Association (VARA) license.

U16/U18/U21 (14 years and older as of December 31, 2023) \$1265.00

- Alpine Non-Scored Athlete (14-24) \$100 (Does not include access to U.S. Ski & Snowboard points list)
